# **ORDINANCE NO. 10-03**

# AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A CURFEW WITHIN THE CITY OF HEBRON, MORTON COUNTY, NORTH DAKOTA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HEBRON, MORTON COUNTY, NORTH DAKOTA, AS FOLLOWS:

### SECTION 1. CURFEW.

- (a) It is unlawful for persons fourteen (14) years of age or less to loiter, idle, wander, stroll, play in or upon, or drive or ride about in a vehicle or be in or upon, the public streets, highways, roads, alleys, or public buildings, places or grounds between the hours of 10:30 p.m. (CT) and 5:00 a.m. (CT).
- (b) It is unlawful for persons fifteen (15) years of age to loiter, idle, wander, stroll, play in or upon, or drive or ride about in a vehicle or be in or upon, the public streets, highways, roads, alleys, or public buildings, places or grounds between the hours of midnight and 5:00 a.m. (CT).
- (c) It is unlawful for a person sixteen (16) years of age but not yet eighteen (18) years of age to loiter, idle, wander, stroll, play in or upon, or drive or ride about in a vehicle or be in or upon, the public streets, highways, roads, alleys or public buildings, places or grounds between the hours of 1:00 a.m.(CT) and 5:00 a.m. (CT).

This section does not apply to persons accompanied by a parent, guardian or other adult person having their care and custody, or to persons upon emergency errands, or legitimate business directed by their parents, guardian, or other adult person having their care and custody, or to persons traveling to or from a location outside the City on legitimate

This section also does not apply to a person in attendance at, or traveling between that person's home and a place of legitimate employment or an event or activity sponsored by or associated with a school, church, or similar organization, or an organized sporting, political, theatrical, or other like event or activity, within thirty (30) minutes of the end of the work shift, or the conclusion of the event or activity.

#### SECTION 2. DUTY OF PARENTS.

It shall be unlawful for any parent, guardian, or other person having the legal care and custody of any child under eighteen (18) years of age, to allow or permit any such child, ward or other person under such age, while in such legal custody, to loiter, idle, wander, stroll, play in or upon, or drive or ride about in a vehicle or be in or upon any public streets, highways, roads, alleys, or public buildings, places, or grounds within the City of Hebron, Morton County, North Dakota, within the time prescribed by, or contrary to, the provisions of this article.

### SECTION 3. PENALTY.

Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance is guilty of an infraction and shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine not exceeding Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00). SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE.

If any provision of this Ordinance or its application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance, or the application of the provisions to other persons or circumstances is not affected.
